### Day 1: Arrive Nairobi (4<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

On arrival at the Jomo Kenyatta International Airport, you will be met by our company's representative and after a short brief regarding your safari you will be transferred to your hotel for overnight

### Day 2: Amboseli National Park (5<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

You will be picked up at your hotel after breakfast and head for Amboseli National Park. On arrival you will be transferred to your lodge for check in. You will have lunch here and in the late afternoon depart for the evening game drive and exploration of this national park which is famous for its huge herds of elephant.



*Amboseli National Park is famous for its huge herds of elephant and the view of Mt. Kilimanjaro which is the tallest Mountain in Africa and the biggest majestic standing mountain in the world best viewed from Amboseli. Wildlife and birds to be seen here includes, Maasai giraffe, hyenas, lions fringe eared Oryx and over 400 species of birds*

### Day 3: Amboseli National Park – Lake Manyara National Park (6<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

Enjoy an early breakfast and check out of the lodge. Depart for Lake Manyara National park to arrive in good time for lunch and later depart for an afternoon game drive.



*Lake Manyara National Park sits at the base of the Great Rift Valley and is famous for its tree-climbing lions. The large shallow lake and the surrounding landscape is extremely scenic. Large fig and mahogany trees can be seen in the forest around the park gates and to the south are acacia woodlands where most of the larger mammals can be found. The lake and the surrounding area are home to over 300 bird species, including flocks of migratory flamingo. During the dry seasons, the lake waters recede exposing large grass covered areas*

#### Day 4: Lake Manyara National Park– Serengeti National Park(7<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

After breakfast, check out of the lodge, depart to Serengeti national Park. Enjoy game viewing en route to the lodge. Lunch will be at the lodge followed by relaxation. You will have an afternoon game drive in the Serengeti National Park.



*The Serengeti is one of the most famous parks in Africa and is synonymous with wildlife and classic African scenery. It is Tanzania's oldest park and a Unesco World Heritage Site. It is home to the spectacular wildebeest migration and offers top-class wildlife viewing throughout the year. Serengeti offers some of the most scintillating game-viewing in Africa: great herds of Buffalo, smaller groups of Elephant and Giraffe, and thousands upon thousands of Eland, Topi, Kongoni, Impala and Grant's gazelle.*

#### Day 5: Serengeti National Park (8<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

After breakfast, with picnic lunch depart for a full day game drive in the vast and sensational Serengeti.



*Golden-manned lion prides feast on the abundance of plain grazers. Solitary Leopards haunt the acacia trees lining the Seronera River, while a high density of cheetahs prowls the southeastern plains. Almost uniquely, all three African Jackal species occur here, alongside the spotted Hyena and a host of more elusive small predators, ranging from the insectivorous aardwolf to the beautiful serval cat.*

### Day 6: Serengeti National Park - Masai Mara Game Reserve (9<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

After an early breakfast, head for Masai Mara National Park with a mini-game drive enroute.



*Masai mara is globally famous for its exceptional population of lions, leopards and cheetahs, game, and the annual migration of zebra, Thomson's gazelle, and wildebeest to and from the Serengeti every year from July to October, known as the Great Migration. Many National Geographical Documentaries have been recorded here.*

### Day 7: Masai Mara Game Reserve(10<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

After breakfast, you will check out of the lodge and head for Sarova Mara Game Camp, where you will be spending the next two nights, You will enjoy a mini game drive enroute. Upon check in, refresh and relax at the pool. After lunch you will have an afternoon game drive in the Vast Savannah.





*Famous for the abundance of lion, the Great Wildebeest Migration and the Maasai people, well known for their distinctive custom and dress, it is without a doubt one of Africa's most famous safari destinations. Animals to be seen here include the big five, zebras, giraffes, topi, kongoni amongst many species of wild life. There are over 300 species of birds to be seen.*

### Day 8: Masai Mara (11<sup>th</sup> July 2024)

Embark on an early morning game drive. You will have the opportunity to see the wildlife, learn about animal behavior and the environment around you. Spend the rest of the morning relaxing.

In the afternoon you may visit the Maasai Village,(Optional). In the evening you will have dinner and later enjoy a bonfire.
